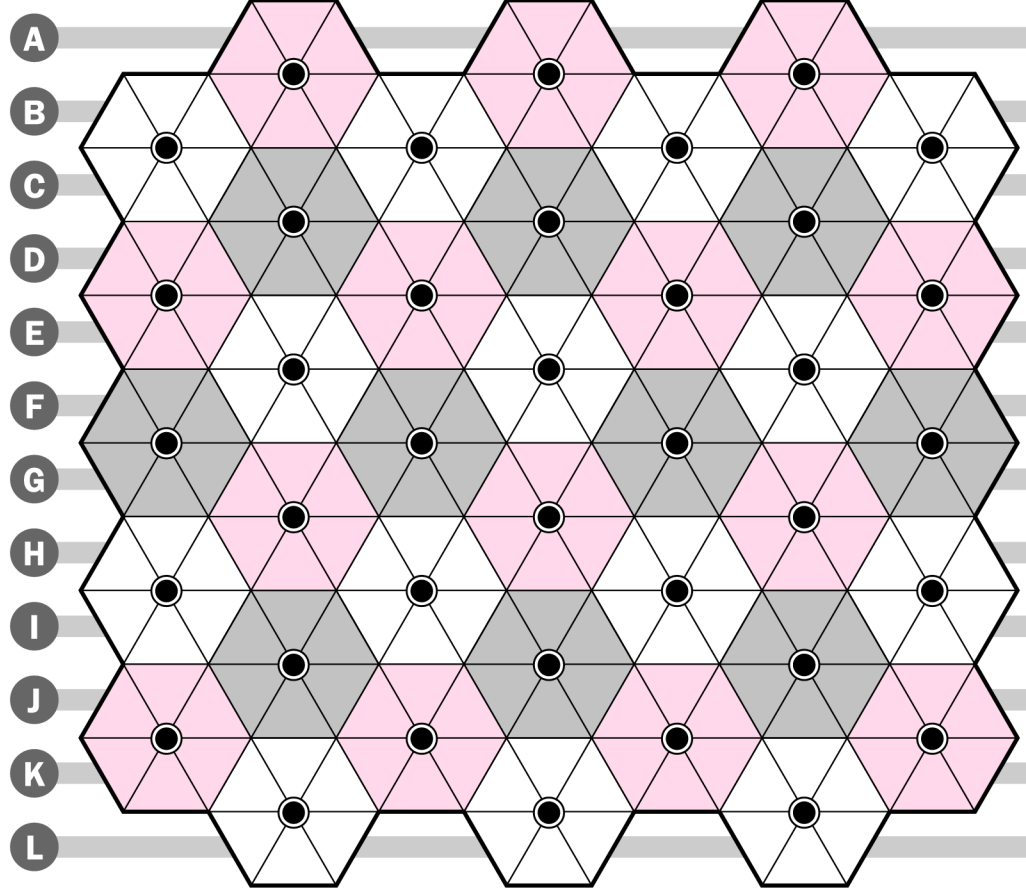


ROWS GARDEN #2

Each Row of this garden contains two consecutive answers reading from left to right (except Rows A and L, which contain one answer reading across the nine protruding spaces). Bloom clues are divided into three lists, White, Pink, and Gray; the answers from each list should be placed in the appropriately-colored hexagons, starting in any space and reading clockwise or counterclockwise. All three Bloom lists are in random order, so use the Row answers to determine where to plant each Bloom.
